If you choose music other than the traditional music, please consult the minister & he will put you in touch with the organist. You may be asked to provide, or pay for, additional sheet music.

7 There need to be two witnesses, who, as well as the Bride and Groom, will sign four copies of the wedding certificate during the service.

8 The person who will walk up the aisle with the Bride at the beginning of the service, if anyone – it could be the groom.

The wording is 'Who brings this woman to be married to this man?'

The Bride does not *have* to be 'brought', but may be if you choose.
